IN 1934 the Troop, then 3rd Essendon, re-formed and started to meet at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lamont, McLean Street, West Brunswick. Original Members were: N. Anderson, A. Blair, S. Simms, H. Numa, J. Danks, and J. Thompson. Through the generosity of Mr. F. J. Bowden, the troop later transferred to a tin shed on his property in Hopetoun Avenue, West Brunswick. The troop continuing to grow in numerical strength. "Grandad" saw the necessity for a larger meeting place, and a Working Bee immediately extended the shed to twice its original size. Having received a grant of land from the Brunswick City Council, the Group was re-named 4th City of Brunswick in March, 1946. Early in 1949 the Group Committee approached the Brunswick City Council for permission to use the Kitchener Street Hall for Scouting, and through their generosity this was granted, and meetings were commenced in July. Realizing the necessity of having a Hall of our own, the Committee were fortunate in securing a Building, which was shifted, erected and extended on its present site. The Group transferred its activities to Jolley Street in July, 1950, work being continued on the building right up to the present.

Looking Ahead—
